CLARIFICATION AND UPDATE OF THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN LWSC, UC DAVIS SAILING TEAM AND HIGH SCHOOL SAILING TEAM

UC DAVIS SAILING TEAM

- 1) The UC DAVIS Sailing team and its members shall comply with all applicable laws in connection with sailing at LWSC.
- 2) UC DAVIS Sailing team members must complete and submit an application form provided by LWSC for student membership to the LWSC.
- 3) All UC DAVIS Sailing team members shall pay quarterly dues of \$15 to LWSC for each quarter in which they participate in sailing at LWSC. There are 3 quarters per year and quarters begin in September, January and May.
- 4) Upon joining LWSC each UC DAVIS Sailing team member shall be entered in the roster of LWSC members as a student member and is eligible to obtain club keys from the Vice-Commodore upon payment of the standard deposit.
- 5) Each UC DAVIS Sailing team member shall volunteer four hours of service to LWSC each quarter. The UC Davis Sailing team captain and LWSC port captain will cooperate to keep track of volunteer service.
- 6) The UC Davis Sailing team may store five CFJs and one Laser sailboat and associated lines, sails and rigging on the premises of LWSC in accordance with requirements established by the Port Captain. The boats of the UC Davis Sailing team do not belong to LWSC.
- 7) The UC Davis Sailing team may use LWSC boats and other personal property at Lake Washington when they are available for use. All use shall conform to the Port Captain's published rules.
- 8) The UC Davis Sailing team shall post its regular practice schedule on the clubhouse outdoor bulletin board and update it as necessary.

HIGH SCHOOL SAILING TEAM

- 1) The High School Sailing team shall be coached by adults, at least one of whom shall be present at all team practices and events of every kind. LWSC will provide a book of emergency procedures to the team's leader. The coaches and activities shall comply with all applicable laws in connection with sailing at LWSC.
- 2) The team may make its own rules for participation including the setting of any fees, eligibility standards and selection of sailing activities. The program is not limited to children of members of LWSC.

- 3) All prospective team members shall submit an application to the team identifying their health insurance providers, emergency contact information and a sailing waiver of liability form completed by their parents or legal guardians.
- 4) The High School Sailing team is sponsored by the LWSC but it shall maintain its own funds independently. The High School Sailing team shall prepare a budget for the expenditure of those funds and may make spending and purchasing decisions on its own. Team boats and other personal property are not owned by LWSC.
- 5) The High School Sailing team shall pay to LWSC 20 percent of its gross annual revenue as compensation for use of the club's facilities and personal property.
- 6) The High School Sailing team may store four CFJ sailboats and associated lines, sails and rigging on the premises of LWSC in accordance with requirements established by the Port Captain, so long as the LWSC has floating storage available for those boats.
- 7) The High School Sailing team may use LWSC's boats and other personal property at Lake Washington when it is available for use. All use shall conform to the Port Captain's published rules. The possible use of LWSC property off site is left to future discussion. Use off site for up to three days may be authorized in advance by the Port Captain on a case by case basis.
- 8) The UC Davis Sailing team shall post its regular practice schedule on the clubhouse outdoor bulletin board and update it as necessary.

The LWSC Board may change the terms of its sponsorship of the UC Davis Sailing team and the High School Sailing team by vote of the membership attending any properly noticed monthly meeting. Discipline may be imposed for significant violations of these requirements in accordance with LWSC Bylaws, Article 1, Subdivision D.
