



Lake Washington Sailing Club 2008 Jazz Cup Notice of Race 21-22 June 2008

The Lake Washington Sailing Club invites you to race in our annual Jazz Cup Regatta, on new dates: Saturday June 21st, and Sunday June 22nd. Lake Washington is the turning basin for the Port of Sacramento and one of the best places to sail in Sacramento with fast courses, consistent breezes, and friendly sailors. Our facilities include a clubhouse with a large deck, a launch ramp, and eight hundred pound capacity hoist. This regatta is open to any centerboard sailboat 20ft in length and under. We anticipate the following fleets: Laser, Lido 14, C-15, Sunfish, Thistle, and at least one open class.

Entry & Fees

An entry form is attached or available at the Lake Washington Sailing Club Web site. The entry fee is \$45 for the series with a \$10 discount if postmarked by June 16 2008. The entry fee covers all racing and regatta awards.

Racing

Up to six short-course races are scheduled for Saturday and up to three short-course races are scheduled for Sunday. Racing will be held under the 2005 to 2008 ISAF, US Sailing rules and the sailing instructions.

Scoring and Classes

Four class boats will constitute a class, and may receive a class start. All other boats will sail in open Portsmouth divisions.

- One to four starters: 1 award
- Five to Ten starters: 3 awards
- Eleven to 15 starters: 4 awards
- Fifteen or more: 5 awards

Post race video highlights and social hour Saturday night 6:00-7:00PM at "El Puerto" 2248 West Capital Ave. in West Sacramento. No host dinner to follow. Sunday morning breakfast: All you can eat pancakes for \$4 starting at 8:00AM till 10:00AM

Boat Storage

Boats may be stored on the water or in the parking lot over night (there is no night time security). There is no overnight camping at the facility or Port of Sacramento.

Location

To get to the clubhouse take the Harbor Blvd exit off of Business 80 in Sacramento. Turn left from East bound 80 and Right from West bound 80, onto Harbor Blvd (going South) at the end of the exit ramp. Turn right on Industrial Blvd. Turn left into the Port at the yellow Iron Gate (less than ¼ mile) and cross the railroad tracks. Travel approx. 25 yard and turn right onto the paved road. Follow the paved road to the end and turn right on to the gravel road to the parking lot. Map and pictures located on our web site
