SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The US Racing Rules of Sailing 2012*.

2 ENTRIES

There is no entry fee for this event however donations are encouraged. Entries may be made for either of the two one-design fleets, or the open fleet. Entrants into the fleet racing are to provide their own boat. Fleet racers will sail in one of three fleets: two one design fleet or an open class fleet. The two one design fleets will consist of the one design class's most represented, i.e with the most number of boats. All other fleet race entrants shall sail in the open fleet. 3 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located in the UCD panel of the notice board.

4 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

Signals made ashore will be displayed from the flagpole located on the clubhouse deck. If a postponement is signaled ashore, the warning signal will be made not less than 15 minutes after flag AP is lowered.

5 SCHEDULE and CLASS FLAG(S)

9:00-10:00	Registration Opens
10:30	Competitors Meeting
11:00	First Warning
5:00	No Start After

Class flags will be announced at competitors meeting.

6 RACING AREA

The racing area will be in Lake Washington / Port of Sacramento Turning Basin.

7 COURSE[S] and MARKS

The courses will be as described by the course sheet. The course will be designated by numeral pennant flow during the starting sequence. All course marks will be yellow floating balls.

8 STARTING / FINISHING LINES STARTING SYSTEM

The starting and finishing lines will be between orange flag on the Race Committee boat and red ball. We will be using a 3-minute sequence. The starting system will be manually blown using whistles. The start/finish line will be "**restricted**", That is, you cannot cross the start finish line unless you are starting/finishing.

9 TIME LIMIT

The time limit for each race will be 20 minutes for the first boat to finish.







10 PROTESTS

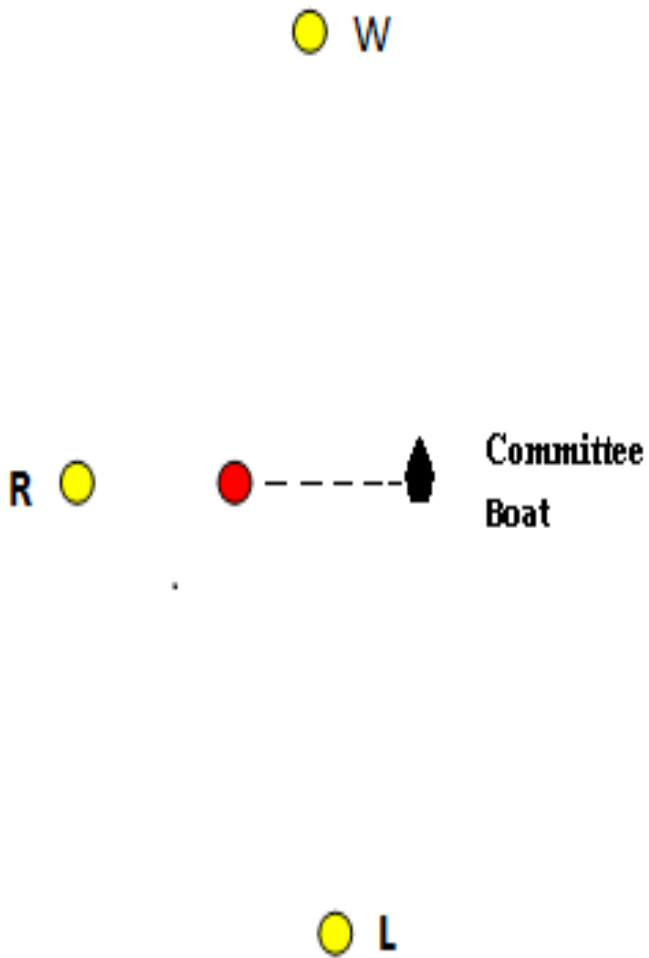
