Lido District 2 and the Lake Washington Sailing Club invite you to the Lido District 2 Championship regatta. This regatta will be held in conjunction with the LWSC One Design Series final day of racing. Washington Lake is located at the turning basin for the Port of West Sacramento. You can expect afternoon delta breezes at around 8-12 knots with an occasional 20-knot day. Our facilities include a clubhouse with large deck, restrooms, a launch ramp, and a 2000-lb. capacity hoist.

Entry Fees

Entry fee is \$10. See Entry Form. This fee covers LWSC expenses.

Racing & Rules

Up to five races are scheduled for the day. The races will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing, as modified by the sailing instructions (available race day onsite).

Eligibility

- All Lido 14 skippers are eligible to participate. Lido 14 sailors residing outside of District 2 are welcome and encouraged to join. Membership in the Lido 14 Class Association is not required. Current or past measurement of Lido 14 is not required.
- Only current members of the Lido 14 Class Association who reside in District 2 (Northern California) and are sailing a class-legal Lido 14 boat shall be eligible for the District 2 Trophy.
- Skipper and crew weight must total a minimum of 300 lbs.

Awards: Winners announced after last race. Trophy presentation to follow awards of One Design fleets.

Location and Racing Area: Lake Washington Sailing Club is located at the turning basin for the Port of West Sacramento. Exit Capital City Freeway (Business 80 / SR-50) at Harbor Boulevard south, then right turn onto Industrial Boulevard, and turn left across railroad tracks onto Boathouse Road south of 2901 Industrial Boulevard. In Google Maps, search for 3101 Industrial Blvd., West Sacramento, CA and follow Boathouse Road to the south. Look for LWSC signs.
