

2023 Mid-winter Series February - April

The Lake Washington Sailing Club has scheduled a series of Mid-Winter races during February, March and April. Each weekend a separate designated one design class will race.

Located at the Port of West Sacramento, LWSC's facilities include a grass area with picnic tables, a one-ton capacity hoist, launch ramp and dinghy ramp for easy water access.

All participating sailors must follow the LWSC's COVID guidelines stated below.

The second Saturdays – Sunfishes and CFJs – is also intended as a learning and practice event. While the racing is in standard format, we encourage beginners to participate, and coaches will be on hand to provide guidance. So, come out, grab a boat, and learn how to race!

Schedule of Races - Febuary, March & April

1st Sat. 1 PM Warning – Laser (February 4, March 4 & April 1)

2nd Sat. 1 PM Warning–Sunfish and CFJ (February 11, March 11 & April 8)

3rd Sat. 1 PM Warning—Thistle (February 18, *Sunday March 19* & April 15) — There is a conflict with the WOC Striper Derby on the 3rd Saturday in March.

4th Sat. 1 PM Warning–Lido/C15 (February 25, March 25 & April 22)

Registration

To register go to the calendar page of the club website at www.lwsailing.org and click on the date you plan to race. There will be no in-person registration at the club.

Cancellation Notice: If there is a change of weather or COVID or other health restrictions are imposed by Yolo county and it's determined that it is not safe to host the race, you will be notified by email if registered and the cancelation will be noted in the LWSC calendar no later than the Friday at 6 PM before the event.

Entry fee is \$25 for the series. (High School and College students \$15.00). There is no "single-day fee."

Racing & Rules

Up to five races are scheduled each day. Racing will be governed by rules as defined in the 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing. Sailing Instructions and course sheet will be available on the club's website.

Scoring & Awards

The RRS Appendix A low point scoring will be used. There will be 1 throw-out for every 5-race day. Entrants will be scored DNS for any races they did not start. Series trophies will be award after the last race in April. Special Awards will be conferred upon racers who participate in at least three race days for each of the fleets – "The Ironperson Award."
